## 1. GENERAL

### 1.1 MANDATORY DRILL/ATTENDANCE

February's drill is our Annual Inspection and attendance is mandatory. Additionally, Cadets that have fallen below the 70% attendance rule will be dropped at February's drill.

### 1.2 REPORTING DRILL ATTENDANCE

Cadets are required to report drill attendance no later than 1800 on Sunday, February 21<sup>st</sup>. When reporting your attendance you must inform your Squad Leader of the following:

- You will be attending the entire weekend or a portion
- Reason not attending or missing a portion of the weekend

Squad Leaders provide attendance to your Leading Petty Officer.

All Leading Petty Officers (*including League Cadet LPO*), report attendance to BATCOM by 1800 on Monday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>.

BATCOM will provide consolidated reporting to the Operations Officers and Commanding Officer.

### 1.3 REPORTING AT DRILL

With the number of Cadets within our unit, it is important that everyone is aware of proper reporting. To better streamline check-in the following information is provided.

- At 0715 Staff and Leadership Cadets (BATCOM, LPOs, Squad Leaders, Watchstanders, Yeomans, Training Cadets, and Supply Cadets) report in Dress Blues.
- At 0730 All Hands report in Dress Blues.
- Report via the Quarterdeck by presenting ID card, saluting and requesting permission to come aboard.
- Proceed to one of two tables (Battalion or Training Ship); X-Ray personnel that attended last drill report to either the Battalion table (Sea Cadet X-Ray) or Training Ship table (Leaguer X-Ray). New Cadets will be directed to the appropriate table via the Quarterdeck.
  - At table, Cadet will pay drill fees, turn in medications, turn in coursework, and turn in *all* required paperwork.
- Fall in.

**1.4 RATING BADGES AND RIBBONS**

When you are promoted you are provided one rating badge (exception to those advancing to E2). You are to return all old rating badges the following drill for exchange when meeting with the Training Officer for course assignments. When you earn a ribbon, it is realized that your ribbon bar needs to be exchanged. You are required to bring your ribbons in the following drill for exchange of the bar for a new one. If the bar is undamaged this is a one for one exchange (no cost to you). In having you bring your ribbons in, this allows you to make sure that all your ribbons look sharp. Be proud of your accomplishments!
